Traditionally, papermaking technology has only contained 30% recycled fibers due to the quality of the paper. However, papermaking technology today has allowed for 100% recycled fibers that meets or exceeds previous quality expectations and printing standards. The Grays Harbor Paper used in Sustainable Group's ReWrite is a high quality printing and writing paper and is available in offsets, opaques and copy paper.
